

Your Frequently Asked Questions

- How many photographs do you take at our wedding?
- As many as we can. It depends on the weather, number of guests, time allocated to photography, the guests etc, etc. On average between 300 to 600.
- Why are you less expensive than other photographers?
- We believe in charging reasonable, affordable rates without over charging like so many photographers do. We don't charge you excessive amounts for the privilege of owning and printing your own images. We don't charge excessive amounts for printing your images by using our printers. The choice is yours and it is good to have that choice.
- What format are the photographs given to us in?
- The photos are shot in RAW, and then converted to High Resolution Jpeg files for future-proofing. They are then colour processed and converted to high res jpeg files for you. Low resolution files are processed and uploaded to your own private web space where you can view them anywhere in the world.
- Can I get more copies of the CDs?
- Yes you can, see our price list for prices.
- How long do you keep the photos for?
- We data store our images for life, never deleting an image regardless of age. We archive all our wedding photographs on huge hard drives and backup to DVD so they can always be replicated if required.
- How long does your photographer/s stay for?
- We stay for as long as you have requested but normally from the bride getting ready to the first dance so capturing everything which normally is around 8/10 hours.
- Do you carry back-up equipment in case of failure?
- Yes we do, we shoot on Nikon professional DSLR cameras and use the best quality lenses which are fully weatherproof.
- Do you require feeding at our wedding?
- Absolutely not. You have enough expense and worry without having to feed the photographers.

- Do you have insurance?
- Yes, I have both public liability and professional indemnity insurance.
- Do you cover civil partnerships
- Yes, no problem.
- Do you charge for mileage?
- Within reason the mileage is included. We do the occasional wedding outside of Kent and Sussex, in Hertfordshire, Surrey and Central London and we charge only .45p per mile only.

- What are type of photography do you do?

- There are three styles of wedding photography to consider.
- Traditional (Classical) - Formal style where the guests are posed and arranged.
- Reportage (Documentary style) - Creative, natural and relaxed without too much photographer intervention.

Contemporary - A mix of the above two styles.

- What is your style of wedding photography?

- Reportage is my theme due to my vast experience as a press and PR photographer. Being clever, quick witted and inspirational and getting in the right position prior to the picture being taken is an art and you have to know how to read the situation before it happens. Understanding people is one of my skills and that's what you are paying for, someone who understands how people react and being ready for that reaction and capturing it.

- Do you do formal pictures too?

- Yes I do, Traditional wedding pictures are always included in my list and I am sure they are in yours too. I do like to spend some time with the bride & groom alone prior to the reception to capture the classic togetherness moments of marriage before the party starts. This should only take 15/20 mins.

- Can you help us with albums?

- Yes we can, please go to our album pages.

- Are you a member of a professional body?

- I am a member of the SWPP & BPPA

- What happens if you are ill?
- Illness is a worry for us all in this business but I have several other photographers who shoot in a similar style and would cover any wedding that I found myself unable to cover.
- Do you cover weddings outside of the southeast?
- Yes I do. If further than 100 miles away from Tunbridge Wells then a mileage fee will apply or overnight accommodation the night prior to the wedding if more than 250 miles away.
- Can we arrange a meeting prior to our wedding date?
- I can meet the couple at my office for an informal chat where they can view a sample album of my work. However, bookings can be made without meeting if the distance is too far away.
- How do we make a booking?
- Just complete an online booking form and return with your booking fee (£250) to secure your date in our diary. The balance is due two weeks prior to the wedding date.
